On the first day, the visits to the Recycling Center (Thermi) and Wastewater Treatment Plant of Eastern together with the tour of the Infrastructures of the Dept. of Food Technology (laboratory facilities) were organized.

On the second day, participants visited the Thessaloniki Landfill site (Mavroraxi).

After the visit to the landfill site, the meeting of the partners from Serbia and ATEITH was held.

There was the change of the agenda for the 16.03., due to the unexpected delay of the arrival of participants, caused by the traffic problems. The project meeting, that was originally supposed to be held before the visit of the Thessaloniki Landfill site, was held after the visit.
