STATEMENT ON THE ABSENCE OF INTERFERENCE AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION FOR PUBLIC PROCUREMENT

Pursuant to the article 54, paragraph 10 of the Law on Public Procurement (Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia no. 124/2012, 14/2015 and 68/2015, from now on referred to as the Law) and the Decision on Education dated 21st June 2016 by the Commission for procurement of equipment on the Erasmus + project 561821-EPP-1-2015-EPPKA2-CBHE-JP (2015-3206/001-001) "Waste management curricula development in partnership with public and private sector", in regard to the article 29 of the Law, members of the Commission for public procurement confirm the following by this statement:

- that there is no bond between members of the commission and potential bidders/applicants that can influence the objectivity of the orderer when making a decision in the process of public procurement;
- that members of the commission or persons related to them do not partake in management of potential bidders/applicants;
- that members of the commission or persons related to them do not own more than 1% of shares, that is, stocks of potential bidders/applicants,
- that members of the commission or persons related to them are not employed or engaged by potential bidders/ applicants or have any business relations with them.

In line with the article 3, paragraph 1, item 11 of the Law, the following persons are considered to be related persons in terms of this statement: spouses, unmarried partners, blood kin in the straight line, blood kin in the lateral line concluded with the third degree of kinship, in-laws kinship up to the second degree of kinship, adopter and adoptee, persons among whom the transfer of management rights has been conducted, and persons related in terms of the Law that regulates the income taxes of legal persons.
