Based on the need for procurement of equipment for higher education institutions of the Republic of Serbia, which are partners on the Erasmus + project WamPPP (no. 561821-EPP-1-2015-1-RS- EPPKA2-CBHE-JP (2015-3206/001-001) "Waste management curricula development in partnership with public and private sector", director of the College of Applied Technical Sciences in Nis, PhD Dejan Blagojevic, as an ordering party, has made the following

#### DECISION

On starting the procedure for joint public procurement of goods- equipment

1. The procedure is initiated for joint public procurement of goods, that is equipment for the needs of higher education institutions from the Republic of Serbia, partners on the Erasmus+ project WamPPP, order no. 1-2016.
2. The objective of public procurement is the procurement of goods-equipment.
3. Joint public procurement is not divided into batches.
4. The estimated cost of procurement is 30 000 000,00 dinars.
5. Envisaged dates for conducting individual stages of public procurement procedure are:
  - a) Competition documentation will be prepared in 10 days after making the decision on initiating the procedure;
  - b) Tender will be announced on the college website and the website for public procurement in 2 days after the preparation of the competition documentation;
  - c) The deadline for submission of bids is 30 days, starting with the day when the call was addressed to bidders at 12 a.m;
  - d) Public opening of bids will be carried out on the last day , that is on 18th September 2016 at 1 a.m;
  - e) Decision on the most favorable bid will be made in 10 days after the opening of bids;
  - f) Contracts on purchase of equipment that will be signed by the managing bodies of the project partners for whom the equipment is purchased, will be made in 10 days from passing the decision on the most favorable bid, that is the decision on assigning the Contract on public purchase of goods-equipment.
6. Means for the said purchase are provided by the Erasmus+ project (no. 561821-EPP-1-2015-1-RS- EPPKA2-CBHE-JP (2015-3206/001-001) "Waste management curricula development in partnership with public and private sector".
